

## THE IMAGE OF GOD Jeremias Antonetty

The first ten men from Adam to Noah

1. Adam lived 930 years - the first man or in human likeness
2. Seth lived 912 years - substitute
3. Enos lived 905 years - blood, stranger, servant,
4. Cainan lived 910 years - fixed, dwelling
5. Mahalaleel lived 895 years - praise of God, fame, this name is also connected with the Hebrew word HALAL  
1984 halal (haw-lal');  
a primitive root; to be clear (orig. of sound, but usually of color); to shine; hence, to make a show, to boast; and thus to be (clamorously) foolish; to rave; causatively, to celebrate; also to stultify:  
KJV-- (make) boast (self), celebrate, commend, (deal, make), fool (-ish, -ly), glory, give [light], be (make, feignself) mad (against), give in marriage, [sing, be worthy of] praise, rage, renowned, shine.
6. Jared lived 962 years - a descendant, abundance, a boundary
7. Enoch lived 365 years - initiated, dedicated, trained up, disciplined
8. Methuselah lived 969 years - man of a spear, a missile of attack, sword, weapon
9. Lamech 777 - an overthrower, a strong young man or who is struck
10. Noah 950 years - A comfort, resting place, quiet

### **In the likeness of God we were created**

Gen 1:26

And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth. (KJV)

### **All things are clearly seen in the creation of God**

Rom 1:20

For the invisible things of him from the creation of the world are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even his eternal power and Godhead; so that they are without excuse: After our likeness

1823 demuwth (dem-ooth');

from 1819; resemblance; concretely, model, shape; adverbially, like:

KJV-- fashion, like (-ness, as), manner, similitude.

### **Adam had a son in his own likeness**

Gen 5:3

And Adam lived an hundred and thirty years, and begat a son in his own likeness, after his image; and called his name Seth: (KJV)

### **Murder is forbidden of any man**

Gen 9:6

Whoso sheddeth man's blood, by man shall his blood be shed: for in the image of God made he man. (KJV)

### **We must rid ourselves of every picture, image and idols**

Num 33:50-52

50 And the LORD spake unto Moses in the plains of Moab by Jordan near Jericho, saying,

51 Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, When ye are passed over Jordan into the land of Canaan;

52 Then ye shall drive out all the inhabitants of the land from before you, and destroy all their pictures, and destroy all their molten images, and quite pluck down all their high places: (KJV)

### **There are eight things we must do which will bring forth revival**

5. We must rid ourselves of false teachers, preachers etc.
6. We must break down every false alter, the place of all prayer and worship

Matt 22:20-22

20 And he saith unto them, Whose is this image and superscription?

22 When they had heard these words, they marvelled, and left him, and went their way.
